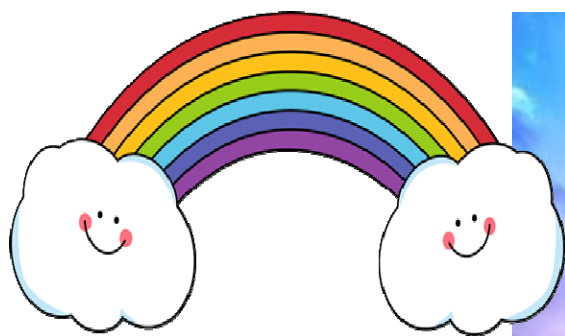
Monday 18th September: This week is Bike Safety Week - School Police Liaison Officer Fiona McCormack is visiting today to present a bike safety lesson.
